

## 2020 KPSC & HI STERILE PROCESSING APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION	In an effort to fill critical vacancies, this apprenticeship creates a long-term sustainable pipeline that produces job-ready Sterile Processing Techs. Kaiser Permanente, in partnership with SEIU-UHW, Unite HERE Local 5, the Ben Hudnall Memorial Trust and the SEIU-UHW Education Fund, has created a program that leverages available funding to provide education and training for staff to promote into Sterile Processing Tech positions.

CERTIFICATION	Apprentices will sit for the CRCST national certification issued by IAHCSMM upon completion of program
