PROGRAM DESCRIPTION	In an effort to fill critical vacancies, this apprenticeship creates a long-term sustainable pipeline that produces job-ready Interventional Radiologist Techs. In partnership with SEIU-UHW, OPEIU Local 30, and Teamsters, the Ben Hudnall Memorial Trust and the SEIU-UHW Education Fund, this program leverages available funding to provide education and training for staff to promote into Interventional Radiologist Tech positions.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA	Full or part time benefit eligible SEIU-UHW, OPEIU Local 30, or Teamsters members from participating facilities; High School Diploma/GED; intermediate level understanding of Math and English; intermediate computer literacy skills
CERTIFICATION	Apprentices are required to earn ARRT certification and registration in the discipline of Vascular Interventional Radiography (VI) upon completion of the program
