PROGRAM DESCRIPTION	In partnership with SEIU-UHW and the SEIU-UHW Education Fund, this program leverages available funding to provide education and training for staff within the Vision Essentials Department to crosstrain as optical dispensers. At the completion of this program, apprentices will be qualified to apply for optical dispenser positions and be eligible to be scheduled as optical dispensers.
